On 11-16-00, I was assigned to assist in the arrest of the suspect in the attached case:

## CHAD EVANS

At 2050 hours, a briefing of the overall operation was given by

SGT. RUSSELL CONTE NH State Police, Major Crime Unit

Uniformed representatives from Maine State Police, NH State Police and Rochester Police were assigned to respond to the front of EVANS' residence located at

191 Milton Road East Rochester, NH 03867

and make contact with him. An arrest warrant was in place for EVANS and a search warrant was in place for the residence.

DET. CAREY CARLBERG and I were assigned as cover officers in the rear of the house as the three representatives approached from the front. The uniformed officers made contact with EVANS and he was taken into custody. EVANS was subsequently transported to the Rochester Police station for processing.

DET. CARLBERG, DET. LISA GERO and I were reassigned to assist

TROOPER JOHN CODY NH State Police, Major Crime Unit

with the search of the residence. A briefing was given by TPR. CODY describing the type of items to be searched for.

At approximately 2130 hours, the search of the residence began. I was first assigned to an area of the kitchen containing cabinets and drawers. In a kitchen drawer to the right of the sink, I located an item matching the description of an item to be seized.

The item was a metallic meat tenderizer, silver in color. It appeared to be on top of several other utensils in the drawer. The pattern on the head of the item could make a pattern similar to the one the search warrant called for. It was numbered, photographed in place and taken into evidence by TPR. CODY.
