I was notified by SP Gray to respond to the Kittery Police Department for

the death of a child

1455 Hrs.

I arrived at the Kittery Police Department and was briefed on the case facts that are as follows: The child was identified as KASSIDY BORTNER, DOB: 2-4-99. BORTNER'S mother was identified as AMANDA BORTNER DOB KASSIDY BORTNER and AMANDA BORTNER live at 191 Milton Road, Rochester, NH with the mother's boyfriend, CHAD EVANS. BORTNER was being babysat at 51 Rogers Road, Kittery by JEFFEREY MARSHALL, MARSHALL'S girlfriend, JENNIFER CONNELLY, who is also AMANDA BORTNER'S sister. MARSHALL'S neighbor, WILLIAM PIERCE, of 6 Johnson Court, Kittery, had information that MARSHALL was concerned about the bruises on KASSIDY BORTNER. EVANS and MARSHALL are reportedly friends. The injuries sustained by KASSIDY BORTNER were described as being extensive bruising on the body and head that included retinal hemorrhaging. There was also scabbing found on the soles of KASSIDY BORTNERS feet and there was also a possibility of sexual abuse. MARSHALL had made statements that when KASSIDY BORTNER arrived at his residence this morning, there were two marks on her face that appeared as if she had been grabbed around her chin. MARSHALL reported that KASSIDY BORTNER had been dropped off at his residence yesterday at 4:15 PM and that EVANS had picked up KASSIDY BORTNER from MARSHALL'S residence at 5:30 PM vesterday. MARSHALL also reported that AMANDA BORTNER dropped off KASSIDY BORTNER at MARSHALL'S residence this morning at 8:15 AM while MARSHALL and his girlfriend, JENNIFER

CONNELLY, were home. JENNIFER CONNELLY works at Perfumania, a perfume store, AMANDA BORTNER works at Old Navy clothing store, JEFFEREY MARSHALL is a self-employed landscaper and CHAD EVANS works for McDonalds as an area representative. The 911 call came in at approximately 12:30 PM from MARSHALL. He had noticed problems with KASSIDY BORTNER and had called CONNELLY for advice. She was too busy and told him to call someone else or 911. MARSHALL attempted to call AMANDA BORTNER but could not get through. MARSHALL eventually called 911 and the ambulance arrived and found KASSIDY BORTNER and MARSHALL on the front porch of the residence. CHAD EVANS is not the father of KASSIDY BORTNER; EVANS has a son, KYLE, who goes to a Christian daycare in Dover. AMANDA BORTNER drops off the children in the morning and CHAD EVANS always picks them up.

1612 Hrs.

Det. Scott Harakles and I (Det. Jeffrey Linscott) interviewed JEFFEREY MARSHALL at the Kittery Police Department. MARSHALL was the babysitter for KASSIDY BORTNER at the time of her death. MARSHALL was questioned on the activities leading to KASSIDY BORTNER'S death and MARSHALL provided background information on KASSIDY BORTNER, AMANDA BORTNER and CHAD EVANS. See attached transcript of interview.

1905 Hrs.

I (Det. Jeffrey Linscott) attended a case briefing at the Kittery Police Department.

2005 Hrs.

Tpr. John Marasco, NHSP and I (Det. Jeffrey Linscott) interviewed TRISTAN EVANS, the ex-wife of CHAD EVANS at the Kittery Police Department. TRISTAN EVANS provided background information on CHAD EVANS, AMANDA BORTNER and KASSIDY BORTNER. TRISTAN EVANS provided information on seeing suspicious bruises on KASSIDY BORTNER and admitted to placing an anonymous call to DCYF Rochester about the bruises and care of KASSIDY BORTNER. See Tpr. Marasco's report for further information on this interview.

2045 Hrs.

Tpr. John Marasco, NHSP and I (Det. Jeffrey Linscott) interviewed BRUCE AUBIE at the Kittery Police Department. AUBIE is a friend of CHAD EVAN'S and provided background information on CHAD EVANS and provided information on seeing bruises on KASSIDY BORTNER. See Tpr. Marasco's report for further information on this interview.

November 10, 2000

I arrived at the Rochester, NH Police Department to assist in the search of CHAD EVANS residence at 191 Milton Road, Rochester. New Hampshire police obtained the search warrant.

I arrived at the CHAD EVANS residence, 191 Milton Road, Rochester, NH and assisted NHSP personnel process the scene. I assisted with diagramming and searching the residence.

2015 Hrs. I cleared the scene in New Hampshire.

November 11, 2000

1905 Hrs. I received a telephone call from IEFFEREY MARSHALL, who advised that earner this date at AMANDA BORTNER'S parents residence in Maine, MARSHALL secreted a running tape recorder on his person and engaged AMANDA BORTNER in conversation about the death of KASSIDY BORTNER. MARSHALL advised he wanted to turn over the tape to me as soon as possible.

November 12, 2000

I interviewed VICKI NORMAN, who provided background information on AMANDA BORTNER and KASSIDY BORTNER. NORMAN also reported observing bruising on KASSIDY BORTNER. See attached Summary of Interview for further information.

1315 Hrs. I interviewed SHANNON GAGNE, who provided background information on AMANDA BORTER, KASSIDY BORTNER and CHAD EVANS. See attached Summary of Interview for further information.

1530 Hrs. Det. Angela Blodgett interviewed AMANDA BORTNER in an interview room at the Gray State Police Barracks. I observed this interview from a separate observation/taping room. See Det. Blodgett's report for further information.

November 13, 2000

1000 Hrs. I attended a case briefing at the Kittery Police Department.

1620 Hrs. JEFFEREY MARSHALL turned over to me the audio tape of his secretly taped conversation with AMANDA BORTNER.

November 14, 2000

1130 Hrs. EFFEREY MARSHALL arrived at the Alfred State Police Barracks for a pre-arranged Polygraph as: MARSHALL decimed to the second of the second second of the second second

November 15, 2000

1000 Hrs. The 911 tape from Kittery PD was turned over to me.

Tpr. John Marasco and I (Det. Jeffrey Linscott) interviewed BRUCE AUBIE at the Kittery Police Department. AUBIE provided more information on CHAD EVANS, AMANDA BORTNER and KASSIDY BORTNER. See Tpr. Marasco's report for further information.

1450 Hrs. I interviewed EMILY CONLEY at the Sanford Police Department.

CONLEY provided background information on AMANDA BORTNER, KASSIDY BORTNER and CHAD EVANS. CONLEY also provided information on seeing bruising on KASSIDY BORTNER. See attached Summary of Interview for further information.

November 16, 2000

O930 Hrs. I attended a case briefing at the Kittery Police Department with members of the New Hampshire Attorney General's Office and with police investigators from the Maine State Police, New Hampshire State Police and the Rochester, NH Police Department.

1315 Hrs. I conducted a video re-enactment with JEFFERY MARSHALL regarding the CPR he administered to KASSIDY BORTNER.

1400 Hrs. I interviewed JEFFEREY MARSHALL regarding the circumstances surrounding the death of KASSIDY BORTNER. See attached transcript of interview.

2305 Hrs. SGT Russ Conti, NHSP and I (Det. Jeffrey Linscott) interviewed CHAD EVANS at the Rochester, NH Police Department after his arrest on a warrant for Manslaughter in the death of KASSIDY BORTNER. EVANS was read his Miranda rights by SGT Conti and EVANS requested his attorney at 2311 Hrs.

November 17, 2000

SGT James White, NHSP and I (Det. Jeffrey Linscott) interviewed TRISTAN EVANS at the Kittery Police Department. An interview with TRISTAN and CHAD EVANS' son, KYLE, had been scheduled for earlier this day that TRISTAN EVANS had cancelled, and TRISTAN EVANS was asked about this cancellation and the scheduling of another appointment.

November 20, 2000

- I attended an interview done of KYLE EVANS by the Victim/Witness Advocates of the Strafford County District Attorney's Office, Dover, NH.

On 11/9/00 at 0800 Hrs., 21 month old Kassidy Bortner is dropped off by her mother, Amanda Bortner, at babysitter Jefferey Marshall's residence in Kittery with severe bruising present. At 1230 Hrs., Marshall finds Kassidy unresponsive and calls his girlfriend, Jennifer Connelly, and attempts to contact Kassidy's mother and the mothers boyfriend, Chad Evans, without success. Marshall calls 911 at 1242 Hrs. and starts CPR on the unresponsive child. The child is transported to

York Hospital and pronounced dead. Investigation reveals history of abuse on Kassidy Bortoer by Chad Evans. Evans arrested and charged.
