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On Tuesday, July 3, 2001 a surveillance of EVANS was planned in an attempt to place EVANS with AMANDA BORTNER, a violation of EVANS' bail conditions. The following State Police personnel were assigned to participate in the surveillance:



Synopsis: Sgt. YORKE, TFC MAYERS, and Tr. HUSE, began the surveillance of EVANS in Keene on July 3, 2001 while he was at work. EVANS was followed from work to home at about 0300 hours on July 4, 2001. At about 0400 hours, he left home in NH registration: 1234417, an older model Toyota pickup truck, and was followed to Vermont where surveillance units lost contact with him in the area of Exit 1 on Interstate 91. Later in the morning, Tr. MCKENZIE checked EVANS' grandmother's house at 1430 Guilford Center Road, in Guilford, VT (EVANS' grandmother's house is located off of Exit 1) but was not able to observe if EVANS or the vehicle he had been driving was there. Tr. SCOTT, Tr. MCKENZIE, and Tr. HARDCASTLE maintained surveillance in the Keene area throughout the remainder of the morning but had no further contact with EVANS. EVANS was located at his residence in Rochester, at about 1440 hours, by Sgt. WHITE. EVANS left his residence in NH registration: 1234417 at about 1515 hours and drove to the "City Limits" Convenience Store on Route 125 in Gonic, where he remained for about twenty minutes. During that time, Tr. DONINI observed a male near NH registration: 1234417 with a blond haired female. Tr. DONINI was not able to identify the male or female from her position. EVANS then drove to a party at a residence in a subdivision off of Flag Road in Gonic. The home's rear and side yards were concealed by a six foot stockade fence, so no observations were made of people attending the party. Attached is a list of some of the vehicles parked at the residence. Several drive-bys of the party were conducted but neither EVANS nor BORTNER were observed. EVANS left the party at about 2200 hours and proceeded north on Route 125. EVANS was stopped by Tr. DOWNEY for an obstructed license plate. EVANS was alone and was given field sobriety tests by Tr. DOWNEY because he had been drinking but was released. EVANS told Tr. DOWNEY that he was going home to his residence on Milton Road in Rochester, but instead EVANS drove to JEREMY HINTON'S residence on Central Avenue in Dover, arriving at about 2240 hours. Surveillance was maintained until about 2300 hours and then ended.


