I asked GAGNE if she had recalled anything else, since her first interview with the police, following KASSIDY'S death. GAGNE said she couldn't recall anything else. She said she hadn't seen A. BORTNER since a couple of days after KASSIDY'S death. GAGNE said she had learned from VICKI NORMAN that A. BORTNER had gone to Texas. GAGNE said that she remembers A. BORTNER crying a lot and saying "I can't believe someone would do this to me."

I asked GAGNE if A. BORTNER had ever attributed blame to anyone for KASSIDY'S death. GAGNE said she hadn't really thought about it until I asked but she did remember some things. GAGNE said A. BORTNER hadn't directly attributed blame, but GAGNE surmised it was between EVANS and J. MARSHALL. GAGNE said she leaned more toward EVANS because of what A. BORTNER had said about J. MARSHALL and J. CONLEY (A. BORTNER'S sister). GAGNE remembers A. BORTNER telling here about J. MARSHALL and J. CONLEY "They're both so good with KASSIDY. I know my sister would never do this to me, I know Jeff would never do this to me." GAGNE also remembered A. BORTNER telling her, prior to KASSIDY'S death, "They're both wicked good with Kassidy, Kassidy loves going over there."
