ON 5-24-96 AT APPROXIMATELY 0216 HOURS THE VICTIM (NICOLE MITCHELL) CAME TO THE POLICE STATION AND REQUESTED TO SPEAK WITH A POLICE OFFICER. I WAS GIVEN THAT TASK. MITCHELL TOLD ME THAT SHE WANTED A RESTRAINING ORDER AGAINST HER BOYFRIEND, WHO SHE IDENTIFIED AS (F. JEFFEREY MARSHALL). SHE TOLD ME THAT MARSHALL HAD GONE TO THE COURT, MADE FALSE ACCUSATIONS AND OBTAINED A RESTRAINING ORDER AGAINST HER. NOW SHE WANTED AN ORDER SO SHE COULD GET BACK INTO HER APARTMENT. I ASKED DISPATCHER GROGAN IF WE HAD PAPERWORK

CONTINUATION OF: DOMESTIC ASSAULT DATE: 05/27/1996

(RESTRAINING ORDER) ON NICOLE MITCHELL. DISPATCHER GROGAN GAVE ME NEW ORDERS,
INCLUDING A COPY FOR NICOLE. THE ORDER HAD BEEN ISSUED FROM THE YORK DISTRICT COURT,
NAMING F. JEFFEREY MARSHALL AS THE PLAINTIFF, AND NICOLE MITCHELL AS THE DEFENDANT. ONE
OF THE RESTRICTIONS INCLUDED THAT THE DEFENDANT WAS RESTRAINED FROM BEING AT OR IN
THE VICINITY OF THE RESIDENCE LISTED AS 51 ROGERS RD IN KITTERY. UNLESS ACTION WAS TAKEN
BY THE DEFENDANT, A HEARING WAS SET FOR 6-10-96. I THEN MADE SERVICE OF THE ORDER TO
NICOLE AND EXPLAINED THE CONDITIONS SET FORTH. I FURHTER EXPLAINED THAT THE POLICE
DEPARTMENT DOES NOT ISSUE RESTRAINING ORDERS AND THAT SHE WOULD HAVE TO SEEK RELIEF
WITH THE COURT. SHE ASKED IF THAT WAS TRUE EVEN IF SHE HAD BEEN ASSAULTED AND
THREATENED BY HER BOYFRIEND. I ASKED HER TO EXPLAIN. SHE STATED THAT MARSHALL HAD HIT
HER, AND THEN PLACED A KNIFE TO HER THROAT AND THREATENED TO KILL HER. I TOLD HER THAT
IT DID NOT CHANGE THE FACT THAT WE COULD NOT ISSUE AN ORDER, BUT I WOULD INTERVIEW HER,
TAKE THE COMPLAINT AND INVESTIGATE THAT COMPLAINT.

IN HER STATEMENT, NICOLE TELLS US THAT SHE LEAVES HER APARTMENT ON TUESDAY 5-21-96.
BECAUSE SHE IS FED UP WITH HER ABUSIVE RELATIONSHIP WITH MARSHALL. SHE TELEPHONES
MARSHALL WHILE SHE'S AWAY AND ASKS HIM TO LEAVE. HE REFUSES. SHE BELIEVES THAT'S WHY
MARSHALL WENT TO THE COURT AND GOT THE ORDER AGAINST HER. FIRST, SHE RETURNS HOME
TWO NIGHTS LATER ON 5-23-96 BETWEEN 2330-2400. MARSHALL IS HOME AND HIS EX-GIRLFRIEND
IDENTIFIED ONLY AS (JENNIFER NEWLAND) IS ALSO THERE. NICOLE SAYS SHE GETS MAD AND GRABS
NEWLAND BY THE HAIR. MARSHALL STEPS IN AND GRABS NICOLE BY THE THROAT AND SEPARATES
THE TWO. NICOLE THEN SAYS THAT WHILE SHE IS BEING HELD, NEWLAND PUNCHES HER SEVERAL
TIMES IN THE FACE. THEN SHE THROWS A LARGE GLASS JAR AT HER, WHICH MISSES AND BREAKS IN
THE KITCHEN SINK. MARSHALL THEN GRABS NEWLAND AND SHOVES HER OUT OF THE APARTMENT.
NEWLAND LEAVES. NICOLE AND MARSHALL THEN BEGIN TO TALK. MARSHALL SHOWS NICOLE THE
RESTRAINING ORDER. NICOLE GETS TIRED AND GOES TO BED. MARSHALL STILL WANTS TO TALK AND
HE WANTS TO KNOW WHERE NICOLE HAS BEEN FOR THE PAST TWO DAYS. NICOLE FINALLY TELLS
HIM THAT'S SHE'S BEEN WITH ANOTHER GUY. MARSHALL LOSES CONTROL AND PUNCHES HER IN THE
BACK. (THERE IS NO SIGN OF INJURY. SHE TELLS ME THAT IT WASN'T A VERY HARD PUNCH). HE THEN

KITTERY POLICE DEPARTMENT
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PUNCHES THE WALL IN THE BEDROOM, LEAVING A DENT. (SHE DESCRIBES THE AREA HIT AS BEING RIGHT OF THE DOOR JAM AS YOU'RE LEAVING THE BEDROOM ABOUT 1/2 TO 3/4 UP THE DOOR). MARSHALL THEN SMACKS HER ACROSS THE FACE WITH HIS RIGHT HAND. (I OBSERVE ONLY A FAINT SIGN OF INJURY AROUND THE LEFT EYE, WHICH I WOULD DESCRIBE AS A LITTLE PUFFINESS AND VERY SLIGHT DISCOLORATION. I DO PHOTOGRAPH THAT AREA, BUT FOR THE RECORD, THE PICTURE LOOKS WORSE THAN THE ACTUAL SIGHT. I TELL NICOLE TO RETURN IF THE INJURY BRUISES AND WE WILL TAKE ANOTHER PHOTOGRAPH). AFTER STRIKING NICOLE, MARSHALL GOES TO THE KITCHEN AND RETURNS WITH A BIG KNIFE. HE HOLDS IT TO NICOLE'S THROAT AND THREATENS TO KILL HER. SHE STATES NEXT, THAT SHE GETS THE KNIFE AWAY FROM MARSHALL AND THEN HE LEAVES. NICOLE ESTIMATES THE TIME OF THE ASSAULT AND CRIMINAL THREATENING TO BE BETWEEN 0100-0130.

NICOLE ADVISES THAT SHE HAS A PLACE TO STAY. I REPEAT THAT SHE MUST ABIDE BY THE ORDER UNLESS RELIEF IS GRANTED BY THE COURT. I RECOMMEND THAT SHE ADDRESS THE ISSUE BEFORE THE COURT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. I ALSO TELL HER THAT I WOULD IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWUP ON HER COMPLAINT AND WOULD ADVISE HER OF OUR PROGRESS.

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TEMPORARY ORDER FOR PROTECTION FROM ABUSE AND NOTICE OF HEARING

v.

NICOLE M. MITCHELL *Defendant*

Upon consideration of Plaintiff's Complaint and request for a temporary order, it is hereby ORDERED that:

- 1. The defendant is prohibited from imposing any restriction upon the person or liberty of the plaintiff;
- 2. The defendant is prohibited from threatening, assaulting, molesting, harassing, or otherwise disturbing the peace of the plaintiff;
- 3. The defendant is restrained from, repeatedly and without reasonable cause, following the plaintiff or being at or in the vicinity of the plaintiff's home, school, business or place of employment;
- 4. The defendant is prohibited from entering the family residence or premises of the separate residence of the plaintiff at (list, unless confidential): _____
- 5. The defendant is prohibited from taking, converting or damaging property in which the plaintiff may have legal interest; and
- 6. The plaintiff is awarded temporary custody of the following minor child(ren) residing in the household: _____

This Order is effective forthwith and will remain in effect until further orders are made by the Court.

WARNING TO THE DEFENDANT: VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER IS A CLASS D CRIME. AS LONG AS THIS ORDER IS IN EFFECT, YOU MUST OBEY IT. NO ONE, INCLUDING THE PLAINTIFF, CAN GIVE YOU PERMISSION TO VIOLATE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDER.

been advised of the following:

1. I have the absolute right to remain silent.
2. Anything I do say will be used in a court of law against me.
3. I have the right of the advice of a lawyer before and the presence of a lawyer here with me during questioning.
4. If I cannot afford a lawyer, one will be furnished me free before any questioning if I desire.
5. If I decide to answer questions now without a lawyer present, I still have the right to stop answering at any time. I also have the right to stop answering at any time to talk with a lawyer before questioning resumes.

WAIVER OF RIGHTS

1. Do you understand each of these rights which have been explained to you?
2. Having these rights in mind, do you wish to talk to me now without having a lawyer present?

I Nicole Mitchell left our house on Tue. 5-21-96, because my boyfriend Jeffery Marshall IS a very violent and abusive man. Everytime I get in a fight or an argument with him he will yell at me, threaten me, and even sometimes physically grab me by the shoulders or throat. So I left Tue. I talked to him over the phone while I was away to tell him to please leave and he could take all - of his belongings. He would not do as I asked. The lease to

apartment is in both of our names.
All bills ~~own~~ are in my name. Almost everything in the apartment belongs to me. Except for the kitchen table and dishes are Jeffery Marshalls.

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He put a restraining order against me, which in his statement ~~are~~ ^{are} false accusations. I left because he is abusive towards me. I told him on 5-23-96 in the afternoon around 12:00pm that if he didn't leave that I was going to put restraining papers against him. So basically he got to the court before me.

I came home tonight around 11:30pm ~~12:00am~~ and found his ex-girlfriend Jenniffer Newland at our apartment. She has a 2 year restraining order against him. I got mad and pulled her hair. Jeffery Marshall immediately grabbed me very hard by the throat so I couldn't breathe and she hit me several times punching me in the ^{face} ^{it} ⁱⁿ ^{the} ^{kitchen} ^{stove} face. ^{Also she grabbed a glass jar and threw it at my head I ducked in} After that he literally grabbed her by the hair and shoved her outside where she fell down on our outside porch and left.

After she left we sat on the couch in the living room and started to talk. This is when he told me he had papers against me, and showed me the papers. (I had not been served yet.)

I said I was tired and went to bed. We were still talking I had my back facing Jeffery Marshall. He wanted to know where I was, what I did the past 2 days. I wouldn't tell him. After I did tell him I was with someone else (another girl) he lost control. He told me Marshall.

Pl . me on the back (middle back). Got
out . bed hit the wall in our bedroom ^{there} ~~was~~
is a dent in the wall. Came back to bed
started talking again and he ^{Jeffery marshall} ~~took~~ took
his right hand and smacked me across the
face. Then ^{Jeffery marshall} ran into the kitchen and got
the biggest knife in the house. I was still
in bed. He got on top of me and held
the knife to my throat and threatened to kill
me. I got the knife away from him when
he left in his truck. All of this took
place at or around 1:00 - 1:30 am this morning

ON 5-24-96 AT APPROXIMATELY 0330 HOURS I WENT TO 51 ROGERS RD TO FOLLOW-UP ON NICOLE MITCHELL'S COMPLAINT. I WOKE MARSHALL UP OUT OF BED AND TOLD HIM I WAS INVESTIGATING A COMPLAINT MADE BY NICOLE. (I DIDN'T TELL HIM WHAT THE COMPLAINT WAS AND HE DIDN'T ASK). HE ALLOWED ME IN AND WE SAT DOWN AT THE KITCHEN TABLE. I ASKED HIM IF HE WOULD TELL ME WHAT HAPPENED TONIGHT. HE SAID THAT NICOLE RETURNED HOME TONIGHT AFTER BEING GONE FOR TWO DAYS AND THEY GOT INTO AN ARGUEMENT AND SHE LEFT AGAIN. HE SAID THAT SHE HAD BEEN DRINKING TONIGHT (I DID DETECT THE ODOR ON HER BREATH WHEN I TOOK HER STATEMENT). AND HE TOLD ME THAT SHE'S ONLY NINETEEN. HE SAID THAT SHE'S BEEN SLEEPING AROUND AND THAT SHE WAS WITH ANOTHER GUY THE LAST COUPLE OF DAYS AND THAT'S PROBABLY WHERE SHE'S GONE NOW. HE ALSO TOLD ME THAT HE WENT AND GOT A RESTRAINING ORDER TO PROTECT HIMSELF. HE EXPLAINED THAT NICOLE WANTED TO KICK HIM OUT, BUT HIS NAME WAS ON THE LEASE TOO, AND HE DESIRED TO STAY. HE TOLD ME MORE THEN ONCE THAT HE REALLY DIDN'T WANT TO GET ONE. HE JUST WANTED TO PROTECT HIMSELF. I ASKED HIM IF THERE WAS ANYONE ELSE PRESENT TONIGHT. HE ANSWERED, "OH YOU MEAN MY EX-GIRLFRIEND". I ASKED WHAT HAD HAPPENED WITH THAT. HE ANSWERED THAT NICOLE AND HIS EX-GIRLFRIEND(JENNIFER NEWLAND) GOT INTO A FIGHT. MARSHALL SAID THAT NEWLAND CALLED HIM EARLIER IN THE DAY AND WANTED TO TALK WITH HIM. SHE WAS THERE WHEN NICOLE CAME HOME, AND AT FIRST NICOLE WAS OK ABOUT IT. THEN SHE GOT MAD AND PULLED NEWLAND'S HAIR. HE SAID HE PULLED THE TWO GIRLS APART AND SENT NEWLAND ON HER WAY. I OBSERVED BROKEN GLASS ON THE KITCHEN SINK AND COUNTER, AND ASKED ABOUT THAT. MARSHALL SAID THAT NEWLAND THREW A LARGE GLASS PITCHER AT NICOLE. IT MISSED HER AND BROKE ON THE COUNTER. (SUPPORTS NICOLE'S STATEMENT) I ASKED MARSHALL IF HE USED ANY PHYSICAL FORCE AGAINST NICOLE. HE SAID THAT HE HAD TO GRAB BOTH GIRLS TO SEPARATE THEM, BUT THAT WAS IT. I ASKED HIM IF AFTER NEWLAND HAD LEFT, DID HE USE PHYSICAL FORCE AGAINST

NICOLE. HE ANSWERED NO. I ASKED DID HE PUNCH THE WALL. HE ANSWERED NO. I ASKED ABOUT THE
 BEDROOM WALL SPECIFICALLY. HE ANSWERED NO AGAIN. AND THEN ALLOWED ME TO CHECK. I
 CHECKED THE AREA AS DESCRIBED BY NICOLE (LEAVING BEDROOM. TO THE RIGHT OF DOOR JAM) AND I
 OBSERVED A DENT. (AGAIN SUPPORTS NICOLE'S STATEMENT). I BROUGHT IT TO MARSHALL'S
 ATTENTION AND HE SAID MAYBE HE DID HIT THE WALL. BUT HE DIDN'T REMEMBER DOING SO. THE
 BEDROOM WAS NOT TORN APART. THERE WAS SOME CLOTHING ON THE FLOOR AND THE BED WAS
 TURNED DOWN AND CRUMPLEDBUT THE REST OF THE ROOM APPEARED IN ORDER. I THEN RETURNED
 TO THE KITCHEN. AND ASIDE FROM THE BROKEN GLASS ON THE COUNTER. THAT ROOM APPEARED IN
 ORDER. I DID OBSERVE A SET OF KNIVES ON THE COUNTER NEXT TO THE STOVE (IN A RACK) SAW NONE
 LYING OUT. I THEN ASKED MARSHALL IF HE TOOK A KNIFE TO NICOLE. HE ANSWERED NO. (I STILL HAD
 NOT TOLD HIM WHAT THE COMPLAINT WAS AND EVEN THE KNIFE QUESTION DID NOT SEEM TO PHASE
