I CALLED DISPATCHER SULLIVAN AND TOLD HER TO EXPEDITE THE AMBULANCE. I THEN RAN TO THE PORCH WHERE THE MALE AND SMALL CHILD WAS. THE CHILD WAS A SMALL WHITE FEMALE ABOUT 1 1/2 YEARS OLD. SHE WAS LAYING ON A SHEET OF SHEET ROCK. SHE HAD ONLY A DIAPER ON,HER EYES WERE OPEN AND FIXED. I ALSO SAW BLACK AND BLUES MARKS ALL OVER THE FACE, CHEN AND NECK AREA. THERE WERE BLACK AND BLUE MARKS ON THE STOMACH AREA ALSO. I ASKED THE MALE WHAT HAD HAPPEN TO THE

I ASKED THE MALE HOW THE CHILD HAD GOT ALL THE BLACK AND BLUE MARKS. HE TOLD ME HE DIDN'T KNOW FOR SURE. HE TOLD ME HIS GIRLFRIENDS SISTER HAD DROPPED THE CHILD OF THAT MORNING FOR HIM TO WATCH BECAUSE THE CHILD HAD BLACK AND BLUES ALL OVER, AND SHE DIDN'T WANT THE DAY CARE TO SEE THE BLACK AND BLUES MARKS. I WAS NOW DOING CPR ON THE CHILD. AS I WAS DOING THIS I COULD SEE THAT THE HANDS AND FEET WERE VERY BLUE LOOKING, I TOUCHED THE CHILDS ARMS AND HANDS AND THEY WERE COLD. HER LEGS AND FEET WERE ALSO COLD AND VERY BLUE. THE ONLY WARM AREA I FOUND WAS UNDER THE CHILD ARM PITS. AS I WAS GIVING MOUTH TO MOUTH I COULD TELL THAT THE CHILDS FACE AND LIPS WERE ALSO VERY COLD. THERE WAS A SMALL AMOUNT OF BLOOD COMING FROM THE NOSE OF THE CHILD, THIS WAS ALSO COLD, AS I WIPED IT FROM THE MOUTH AREA TO DO MORE CPR...

I TOLD DISPATCHER SULLIVAN TO TELL THE AMBULANCE TO HURRY IT UP AND FOR HER TO CALL THE CHIEF AND DET.'S TO THE SCENE ASP.

I ASKED THE MALE HOW THIS YOUNG GIRL GOT ALL THE BLACK AND BLUES ON HER FACE AND HE TOLD ME HE WASN'T SURE BUT SAID HIS GIRLFRIEND SAID SHE WAS HIT BY A BASEBALL. I SAID HOW MANY TIME WAS SHE HIT, BY THE BASE BALL, BECAUSE SHE HAD SO MANY BRUISE

I KEPT CHECKING THE CHILD FOR SIGNS OF LIFE BUT DIDN'T FINE ANY. THE MALE KEPT ASKING IF SHE WAS ALIVE OR NOT, I TOLD HIM I DIDN'T KNOW. I ASKED HIM WHY SHE WAS OUTSIDE ON THE PORCH AND HE TOLD ME THAT HE HAD CHECKED ON HER IN THE HOUSE AND FOUND HER WITH HER EYES OPEN, AND SHE WASN'T RESPONSIVE TO HIM.HE THEN CALL 911, AND PICKED HER UP AND TOOK HER OUT SIDE ON THE PORCH TO WAIT FOR THE POLICE AND AMBULANCE TO ARRIVE.

THE MALE SEEM TO BE UPSET ABOUT WHAT WAS GOING ON BUT ALSO DIDN'T SEEM TO KNOW MUCH ABOUT THE CHILD OR WHAT WAS WRONG WITH HER.

THE AMBULANCE ARRIVED AND THEY TOOK OVER THE CPR. FROM ME. THE KITTERY DET.'S SGT. RON AVERY AND DET. STEVE HAMEL ARRIVED ABOUT THE SAME TIME THAT THE CHIEF OF KITTERY ARRIVED. I TOLD THEM WHAT I KNEW AT THIS POINT AND POINTED OUT THE MALE THAT WAS TRYING TO DO CPR. ON THE CHILD. THERE WAS ANOTHER MALE THERE NOW BUT I DON'T KNOW WHERE HE CAME FROM , HE SEEM TO BE A FRIEND OF THE MALE DOING THE CPR. ON THE CHILD WHEN I ARRIVED.

THE AMBULANCE PEOPLE ASKED ME IF I COULD HELP DO CPR. AGAIN, AND I DID. THE AMBULANCE PEOPLE GOT THE CHILD ON IV, AND MOVED HER TO THE AMBULANCE, WHERE SHE WAS TAKEN TO YORK HOSPITAL.

I WAS TOLD TO STAY AT THE SCENE AND NOT LET ANYONE IN THE APT. UNTIL THE STATE POLICE TOOK IT OVER. I WAS RELIEVED BY A MAINE STATE TROOPER AT ABOUT 20:45 P.M.
