The latent impressions of value developed on exhibits SCC-1 and ABL-1 were compared with the inked finger and palm print impressions of Chad E. Evans (dob [REDACTED] with negative findings.

The suitable latent impressions developed on exhibits SCC-1 and ABL-1 were searched through the Tri-State Automated Fingerprint Identification System with negative findings and have been added to the unsolved latent database for comparisons with new ten print entries.




